Reference and administrative information

The Children and War Foundation is incorporated in Bergen, Norway, and registered in Norway by Stiftelsestilsynet (The Foundation Authority) and Brønnøysundsregisteret (The Brønnøysund Registry).

The Foundation is also recognized in the UK by HMRC to receive Gift Aid on donations from UK taxpayers.

This annual report (årsmelding) consists of an extract of the annual reports both from the Board of Directors (BoD) and Board of Research and Implementation (BRI), with additional information about the purpose and organisation of the Foundation, and a summary of the activities the foundation has executed or been involved in.

The annual report for 2020 has been delayed, as the level of activity has been very much influenced by the covid pandemic.

The Norwegian formal annual reports ("styrets arsberetning") and accounts for 2020 are attached.

THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

The Children and War Foundation aims to promote international research into the short- and longterm effects that war, war-like situations and disasters have on children and their families. The foundation works to obtain and collect grants from various financial sources, and then allocate these to specific research projects.

The Foundation develop evidence-based interventions, i.e. to prepare, compile and maintain manuals that may be used to help the children and their families, and implement such evidence-based interventions.

The Foundation make results of the research available to the public to increase the general and international understanding of the effects of war, warlike situations and disasters on children and their families.

The Foundation maintains the manuals and material developed and makes them available to the public. It furthermore administers training in the use and implementation of the manuals on at a cost only basis, but may ask for reasonable fees and request donations to be able to maintain the manuals and materials and develop new ones relevant to the purpose of the Foundation.

The Foundation strives to minimize its own costs, and to ensure that the grants and contributions received shall be allocated to the activities mentioned above.

Due to the COVID-19 situation, most meetings have been conducted digitally, and all physical activities has been cancelled or been transformed into digital format. The situation have caused a marked reductions of Caw's outgoing activities.

All held in Bergen and partly digitally.

Main activities of the Board of Directors

The Board of directors has had focus on recruiting new members to the board, and two new members have joined the board at the end of the year: Inger Hygen and Maren Hjortland, The Chair of the board Harald Cobbe resigned in June, but were available for the new board until it could be constituted at the of the year. Both board of directors and board of implementation and research tank him sincerely for his contribution to CAW over the whole period since the foundation was established!

The board spent quite a lot of time sorting out formalities and finding a good form for continuing the close cooperation with the new founded UK group, now a separate charity under British legislation. A new memorandum of understanding is signed and regulates the cooperation between the two organisations.

Another important activity has been to continue the development of a concrete and realistic plan for further work and activities in CAW. This will be continued in 2021.

The board held three meetings i 2020, all digital 9. March 15. June 2 November

Main activities of the board of research and implementation

Due to the lock down of most societies the training activities in 2020, had been digital. But this situation has given us the opportunity both to develop and test out digital trainings material and methods. So far it seems that digital trainings in many situations can function as well as physical trainings. An experience that can be used more effectively in situation where we cannot be present physically.

Finished, ongoing and projects put on hold in 2020

Several of the ongoing projects BRI has been involved in is put on hold because of the lock down.

- Olfactory study is put on hold during lockdown
- TRT/foster care in UK: the project is ongoing Responsible: Rachel Hiller, University of Bath; CAW input: training by Bill Yule/UK Group. Implementation delayed by lockdown
- TRT/shantytown Cape Town, Responsible: Rachel Hiller, University of Bath; CAW input: training by Maria Callias; ongoing but implementation is delayed by lockdown
- Brazilian favelas TRT pilot study; Date: 2019-2020; Responsible Ian Barron University of Mass; Input by CAW: Training by Unni and Catelina Frachia; Results now published in : Barron, I., Freitas, F., & Bosch, C. A. (2020). Pilot Randomized Control Trial: Efficacy of a Group-Based Psychosocial Program for Youth with PTSD in the Brazilian Favelas. Journal of Child & Adolescent Trauma, 1-11.
 - Global Mental Health course at the University of Bergen. Unni: Part of International semester at Center for Crisis Psychology, UiB. Semester divided into three parts: global mental health, crises and disasters, and student projects. TRT was included in the crises course. Students are from Norway and Nepal.

- The Arabic version of the manual: The translation and quality control have been done as thoroughly as possible. No other translation has gone through a similar thorough process. The product is finished in terms of the language, but Masa raised the issue of design. She suggests that graphics, branding should be further developed in line with the TRT +. Masa will get a quote of costs so the BRI can decide (by mail) whether to move forward the design.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

During 2020, the foundation had book revenues of totally NOK 154 812.

The expenses have consisted of covering costs in connection with domain names, annual fees, translation of manuals, etc. Furthermore, the foundation has had expenses with and supported various projects. The expenses are amounting to total NOK 276,902.

The operating profit was NOK -122 090 vs. NOK 90 003 in 2019, and the annual profit after interest income was -130,815 vs. NOK 119 138 in 2019. The foundation's equity and debt were at the turn of the year NOK 736 607 vs. NOK 867 422 per 12/31/2019

The foundation's activities do not pollute the external environment and the Board can confirm that the presumption for continued operation is present.

Stiftelsen Barn og Krig, Children and War Foundation, har som formål å fremme internasjonal forskning vedrørende de kort- og langsiktige virkninger som krig, krigslignende og katastrofepregede situasjoner har på barn og deres familier. Stiftelsen arbeider for å samle inn forskningsmidler fra ulike finansielle kilder, og deretter bevilge disse videre til konkrete forskningsprosjekter.

Stiftelsen er registrert hos Stiftelses- og lotteritilsynet, og har sitt hovedkontor i Bergen. Nye vedtekter for stiftelsen ble utarbeidet i 2017. Det ble i den forbindelse besluttet at stiftelsen skal ha et Styre, et Forskningsråd og et generelt Råd.

Utgiftene har bestått i å dekke kostnader i forbindelse med domenenavn, årsavgifter, oversettelse av manual mv. Videre har stiftelsen i 2020 hatt utgifter med og støttet ulike prosjekter. Utgiftene utgjør til sammen kr 276.902.

Driftsresultatet var kr -122.090 mot kr 90.003 i 2019, og årsresultatet etter renteinntekter var -130.815 mot kr 119.138 i 2019. Stiftelsens egenkapital og gjeld var pr. årsskiftet kr 736.607 mot kr 867.422 pr. 31.12.2019.

Stiftelsens virksomhet forurenser ikke det ytre miljø og styret kan bekrefte at forutsetningen for fortsatt drift er tilstede.
