

Teaching Recovery Techniques Training of new Facilitators

A recent evaluation study has confirmed the effectiveness of the TRT intervention in reducing trauma-related symptoms among asylum-seeking and refugee children in Norway. CAW and The Norwegian Institute of Public Health therefore offer training of new TRT-facilitators in Oslo. Teaching of the extended version of the TRT-parenting + is included.

This includes youth older than 18 who arrived unaccompanied in Norway but are not entitled to the special care of unaccompanied minors.
