



Teaching Recovery Techniques for Unaccompanied Minors

REMOTE TRAINING VIA ZOOM

25TH & 26TH NOVEMBER 2021

Youngsters are arriving alone in countries around the world. This may be as a consequence of fleeing war, disaster or trafficking.

This workshop, run by Children and War (UK), will provide training in the delivery of a manualised group intervention for young people arriving unaccompanied in search of asylum or as victims of people smuggling. This is an adaptation of the well-established and evidence-based child trauma recovery intervention Teaching Recovery Techniques (TRT). It has been adapted to address the additional experiences and needs of youngsters who have journeyed alone.

The training is appropriate for all those working with unaccompanied minors who want to run groups, train others to run groups or who are looking for a "taster" session on behalf of a larger organisation. Specific trainings to teams are available on request.
