Many children are traumatized by death or loss during wars, disasters and the recent pandemic

This workshop, run by **Children and War (UK)**, will provide training in the delivery of a manualised group intervention “Traumatic Grief: Teaching Life Skills”. It was written to help children and young people who have been bereaved in traumatic circumstances. Given the number of unexpected deaths caused by COVID, there are now many suddenly bereaved children who can benefit from this course. The intervention consists of 7 sessions for groups of children.

The training will be delivered by William Yule, and David Trickey, experts in the field of childhood trauma and bereavement.

3x6 hour sessions run consecutively over 3 weeks. Delegates are required to attend all sessions and places are limited to 12
